

Un-Single Adjustable Rib Instruction Sheet

Always unload your gun prior to making any adjustment to the rib, stock or changing any choke tube.

The 85TSS un-single barrel is equipped with an adjustable rib that allows you to change the point of impact quickly & conveniently.

The adjustable rib pivots at a point just ahead of the monobloc and is locked in place at the muzzle and a center support screw.

Adjustments are made by first loosening the center support locking screw. This screw is slotted to fit the SKB choke tube wrench. After loosening this screw, the rib can be adjusted up or down by rotating the small knurled wheel located in the muzzle support block. The block is marked with 5 indicating lines for reference.

The center mark is the factory reference point "0". At this setting the shotgun is calibrated to pattern approximately 65 / 35 or approximately 4" above the point of aim. The point of impact can be adjusted from 50 / 50 to 90 / 10 simply by rotating the wheel to change the angle of the rib.

When the rib is set at the chosen height, tighten the center support locking screw with the choke tube wrench.
